The Brandenburg Gate is one of the city's most photographed and visited landmarks, citing itself as Germany's answer to the Eiffel Tower, the Empire State Building or Big Ben. Modelled on the Propylaeum in Athens, it was first brought to the city following the defeat of Napoleon but now represents a peaceful Germany.

Checkpoint Charlie is one of the most famous destinations in the city and is a must visit destination after you have booked your trip and [Berlin hotels](#). Nowadays it is a historical museum for the Berlin Wall, but in it's previous incarnation, it was best known as the crossing point between East and West Berlin.

For some of the best views of the city, head to The Reichstag, the official seat of the German Parliament, you might even be able to see you [Berlin hotels](#) from there. It is always bustling and is an especially beautiful sight after dark as the buildings are lit up, serving as a trendy place for young people to meet up for a night out.

No visit to Berlin would be complete without a visit to what's left of the Berlin Wall. There are two good spots to see what's left on this infamous partition; The East Side Gallery, in Kreuzberg, where artists have painted over the old pieces of the wall as part of a public exhibit bursts with colour and celebrates freedom. For a humbling experience visit the Topography of Terror exhibit in Mitte to see part of the original wall in it's original form. This part of the exhibit focuses on the impact of the wall during World War II and the holocaust.
