Another site located in Delhi that has been designated as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO is the Outub Complex. Constructed between 1191 and 1368, the Outub Minar fascinates both locals and visitors. Ouwwat-ul-Islam Mosque is India's very first mosque but has been partially destroyed. Still existing here is the Iron Pillar marking the center of the Complex, the Ala-i-Minar. The tomb of Imam Zamin, Ala-i-Darwaza was the previous entrance to the mosque and also served as Imam Zamin's residence.

These are only a few of the famous sites in Delhi. In addition to these very spiritual locations, there are many more sites to see and activities to do. Delhi has beautiful parks that are perfect for picnics, and the nightlife is surprisingly active.
