When you prefer a cooler time period to visit the perfect time is November to March when the days are usually dry and the humidity lower, though the island Koh Samui is best seen from June to September.

Thailand's rich culture has been affected by Cambodia, Laos, China, Burma and from the rest of Southeast Asia. Thailand's national religion is Theravada Buddhism and has grown to be central to contemporary Thai identity. The Buddhist religious lifestyle in Thailand has remained nearly unchanged for centuries and countless Thais honor and respect it. This way of life may be seen each day in the floating markets, to the meditation and religious ceremonies. The peaceful and calm nature of the Thais will mean you will receive the warmest of welcomes and end up desiring a lot more Thailand holidays.

Thailand is very accommodating for British citizens. It will take approximately fifteen hours on a primary flight from the United Kingdom. A lot of Thais speak English with major road signs in English and Thai. You do not have to have inoculations for your Thailand holidays, however precautions against hepatitis, malaria and also typhoid are recommended if you are venturing to Northern Thailand or in close proximity towards the borders of the Mekong areas. Currency exchange rates are good and costs are cheap, with a very nice meal in a romantic environment costing about eight to ten pounds for two people.
